What is a Cochlear Implant?

A cochlear implant (also known as 'bionic ear') is an artificial hearing device designed to produce useful hearing sensations by stimulating nerves inside the inner ear.

1. The cochlear implant package and electrode array (or receiver stimulator), and
2. The speech processor and headset.



All the internal parts are placed under the recipient's skin behind the ear during the implant procedure. The implant package contains the circuits that send electrical impulses into the recipient's ear.

The other parts of the implant system are worn externally. There are no plugs or wires connecting the internal and external components.

The coil is held in position against the skin by a magnet and the microphone is worn behind the ear.
